About The NRRA and the Auction

The **Northeast Resource Recovery Association (NRRA)** is a pro-active, non-profit working with its membership to make their recycling programs strong, efficient, and financially successful by:

- ♦ providing cooperative marketing & purchasing and educational & networking opportunities;

In 1981, the Northeast Resource Recovery Association (NRRA) was founded as the **“First-in-the-Nation” Recycling Cooperative** to provide a clearinghouse for current, up-to-date information and a source of technical and marketing assistance. Since then, membership in the NRRA has grown to include over 400+ municipalities, individuals, and businesses in New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island and Maine. The NRRA is nationally recognized as an innovative grassroots organization with competitive pricing, enabling small, rural and large urban communities to manage their own recycling programs. Last year NRRA members sent over **1,268** tons of recyclables per week to market through the NRRA!
