- Committee vote to send Revised SWEEP Standard out for 30 day consensus ballot vote
- Committee Members' ballot votes must be returned and in writing, and any negative vote of disapproval must be germane and persuasive to the Committee as a whole.
- Industry Trade Association Policy is in effect where industry trade associations are encouraged to participate and all participation must only be through one or more industry trade association Members

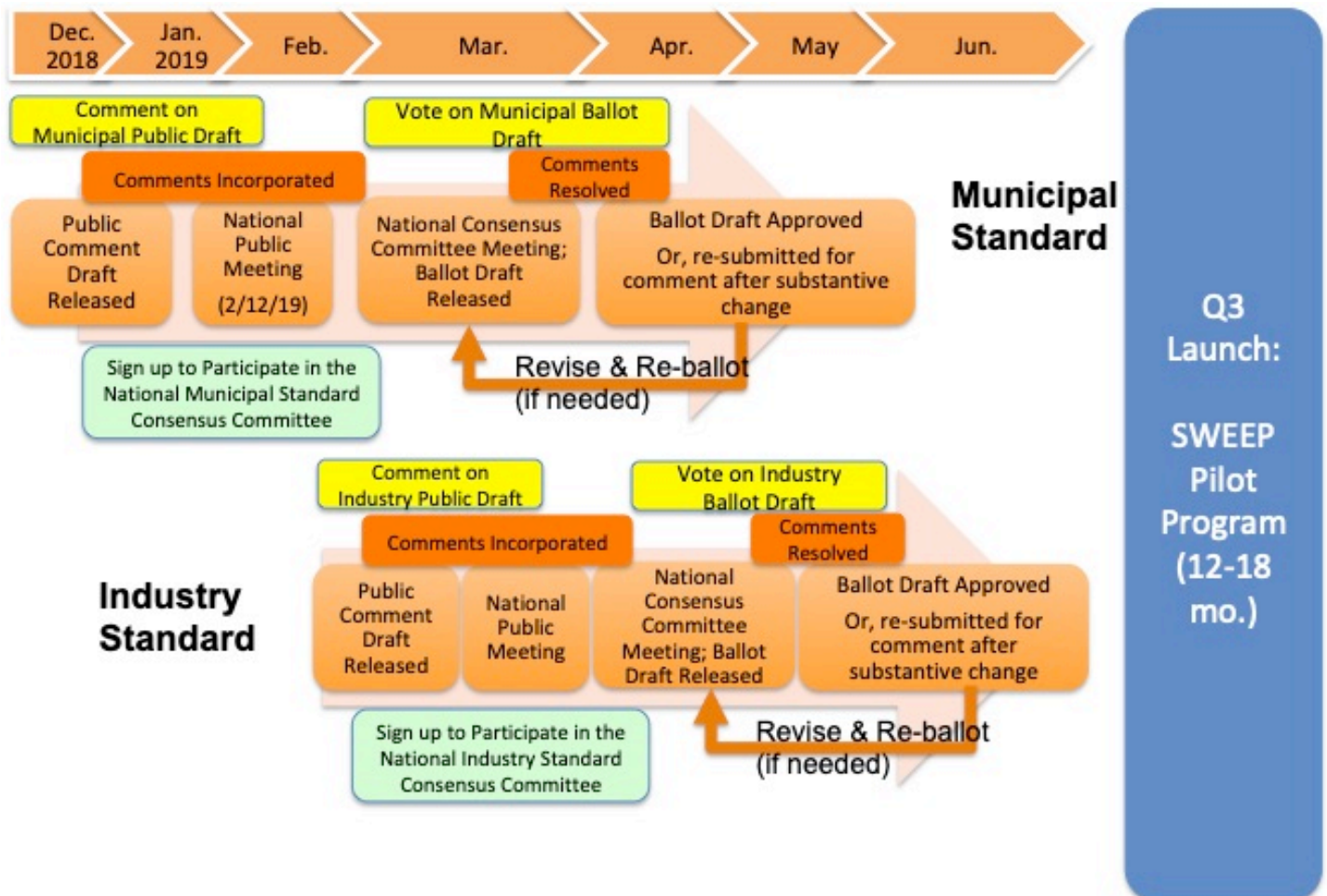


Figure 1: Approximate SWEEP National Consensus Standard Process & Timeline
